Brighter Day Books (BDB) assists local community authors of the Tampa Bay area.

BDB will schedule a date to meet with you. Meetings will be scheduled approximately once per season of the year, in each main area such as: Sarasota/Manatee, Pinellas, Pasco, Polk, and Hillsborough.

Meetings are required to collect a number of book copies from participating authors, and schedule pop up markets to sell the books for you. You save time and money.

How will this work?

Brighter Day Books will need you fill out the form below and provide the method of payment.

Brighter Day Books will update you on sales achieved.

Brighter Day Books does not keep any unsold copies of your books and will return unsold copies a next meeting unless the author elects to have BDB continue to market their work.

Is there anything required in advance? If event space is used to market your book, you will be required to contribute to the cost of event space rental. This cost will vary depending on the number of contributing authors in your community.
